

Scholarship Program 2024

CNB Bank is committed to the communities and businesses we serve and proud to support the next generation of business leaders. We invite eligible students to enhance their education by participating in our annual scholarship contest. Funding is available for students continuing their education in a business-related field. Up to 10 scholarships will be awarded with one winner per eligible school in the amount of \$500 each.

Eligibility

High School seniors with intentions to further their education at a college or university with a business-related degree are eligible to apply. Student must attend a high school in the CNB Bank market area. Dependents of CNB Bank Directors or Officers are not eligible to apply.

Essay Theme:

If you were given a hypothetical budget of \$1 million to invest in a project or initiative aimed at improving your community, what would it be and how would it affect your community over time?

Essay Requirements

- A minimum of 250 words
- Typed and double-spaced
- Participant and/or family names should not appear in the essay

Submission Requirements

Along with the essay, applicants should provide:

- A completed application including a summary of participation in community and school activities,
- One letter of academic reference of a present or past educator, and
- One letter of reference of a non-family member. References may not be bank employees.
- Originally written essay without the assistance of ChatBot technology

Essays will be judged by a selection committee on originality, grammar and how well ideas are expressed. Contributions to both school and community will be considered.

Application and essay must be received by 11:59 p.m. March 15, 2024. Winners will be announced on Facebook and our website on April 12, 2024.
