

The Bruno and Lena DeGol **Family Foundation Scholarship**

- **TOTAL SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT - \$ 4,000.00**
 - Paid in 4 - \$ 1,000.00 annual installments used toward attaining bachelor's degree.
 - Amount paid directly to the institution of higher learning (no internet or cyber schools)
 - Payments disbursed in September of each academic school year
 - To continue to receive the funding for four consecutive years, the student must remain in good academic standing (Minimum 2.5 GPA) and maintain a "full-time" schedule, as outlined by their college / university, for each year they receive the scholarship.

- **QUALIFICATIONS:**
 - Student must be a current student at the school and attended the school for a minimum of three years.
 - Eligible students must have a grade point average of 2.7 (85%) for courses taken from Grade 9 through their first semester, senior year inclusive.
 - Students should be in good academic standing, without a record of major disciplinary action(s).

- **ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS:**
 - Mr. and Mrs. DeGol always stressed the importance of strong leadership, a love of country and community, and living a well-rounded lifestyle. Candidates should be prepared to list all community and school (also sports) activities, and record any leadership positions they were elected to hold.

- **ENDORSEMENTS / RECOMENDATIONS:**
 - Applicants are encouraged to include letters of recommendation from school guidance and teaching professionals, community leaders, and clergy. Please attach no more than three letters when applying. All must be on school letterhead, or that of organization offering recommendation.
