CRITERIA

- Purpose:** The Hansard/Pittman Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors or those attending an accredited trade school. Based on demonstrated academic achievement, financial need, and community service.
- Criteria:** The students eligible for assistance must be a graduating high school senior(s) and intend to continue their education at a four-year college, university or trade school. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need, and the student's community service.
- Guidelines:** Scholarships will be a one-time academic year award. The award will be distributed in one payment in August. The funds will be distributed to the trade school, college or university directly from the fund.
- Amount:** Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$ 1,000.00 each.
- Deadline:** May 3, 2024
